The nonprofit organizations will join Granville and local dignitaries for tours of the house at 6 p.m. The drawing will be held at 7 p.m. The grand prize winner will have the option of choosing the house or \$100,000 in cash.

This year's home is located at 11328 N. Blue Sage Ave., in northeast Fresno's Copper River Ranch neighborhood. The 1,301-square-foot, three-bedroom, two-bathroom cottage-style house has granite countertops, an alarm system and Granville's Eco-Smart technology.
