

Fresno State President Joseph Castro named to national Hispanic college board

Fresno State President Joseph Castro will serve as a member of the [Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities](#) governing board, university officials announced Friday.

Castro began his three-year term Oct. 5.

Several other California university presidents sit on the 19-member board, which has represented colleges that serve Hispanics since 1986. Tomás Morales, president of California State University, San Bernardino, serves as the board chair.

More than 400 colleges and universities, including some in Spain and Latin America, are part of the organization.

Also this month, Castro was named chair of the Hispanic/Latino Presidents group, which is part of the [American Association of State Colleges and Universities](#).
