A new mental health care facility was unveiled at the Veterans Affairs Central California Health Care System medical center during a ribbon-cutting ceremony in Fresno on Friday.



The new center will offer outpatient and substance use disorder programs and group recreational therapy. The building has 13,507 square feet of space.

Last year about 6,200 veterans received mental health care through the Veterans Administration.
