

Caltrans to cut ribbon for Highway 180 segment east of Fresno

Caltrans will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Friday for segment two of the new Highway 180 Kings Canyon Expressway.

The event will start at 10:30 a.m. just south of Highway 180 and just west of Smith Avenue, in the cul-de-sac near Centerville, east of Fresno. The ceremony is open to the public, and refreshments will be provided.
