Three courtyards in WestCare California's residential drug treatment facility in southwest Fresno got a facelift on Thursday morning thanks to an \$18,000 grant from Home Depot and the work of more than 60 volunteers.



WestCare, a Fresno nonprofit, was selected by the Home Depot Foundation to receive one of the 2014 veteran Celebration of Service grants. The money funded a beautification project that improved the lighting and grass and seating areas at the Martin Luther King Boulevard facility.
