

# Fresno State online program combats sexual violence

In an effort to inform students about the issue of sexual violence on college campuses, Fresno State is implementing an interactive online program known as the [Haven](#) program.

The Haven program is one of three sexual violence prevention programs offered by the California State University on the 23 campuses.

Although new federal regulations require that incoming students in the 2014-15 academic year participate in the sexual violence prevention course, Fresno State plans to have all 23,138 students participate.

Students are being contacted through email with information and instructions about the program.

Fresno State has also developed a sexual violence prevention course for faculty and staff, university president Joseph Castro said.
