

Affordable housing complex opens in Reedley

The [Fresno Housing Authority](#) and the [city of Reedley](#) on Thursday celebrated the grand opening of a new affordable housing complex in the eastern Fresno County community.

The development, called Kings River Commons, is located at 2020 E. Dinuba Ave. just northeast of Reedley Irrigator & Supply.

The 60-unit complex has three- and two-bedroom apartments. The property also has a pool, picnic area, playground, fitness center and community center.

“This project has been a collaboration that includes many partners across the county and we are proud to provide quality, affordable housing in the Reedley community,” said Preston Prince, the authority’s chief executive officer and executive director.

The project was paid for with Fresno County HOME funds, Federal Home Loan Bank of San Francisco, Wells Fargo, Central Valley Community Bank, R4 Capital and funding from the housing authority.
