

UCSF Fresno receives training grant to aid underserved areas

UCSF Fresno's Family and Community Medicine Residency Program received a \$206,000 grant Tuesday that will be used to train doctors to practice in underserved areas over the next three years.

The funds will go toward expanded training in women's healthcare, aiding the victims of domestic abuse and other new and existing initiatives. The Family and Community Medicine Residency Program has trained physicians in Fresno County for 40 years.

The program was ranked first out of 37 similar programs in California that applied for the Song-Brown Program, which awarded the grant.
