

Development, water issues common to Fresno, Madera counties discussed at joint meeting

A joint meeting of county supervisors from Fresno and Madera counties Tuesday morning served as an opportunity for leaders to catch up on common issues about development and water.

No decisions were made during the two and a half hour meeting. County staff gave report about the Friant corridor development and the Rio Mesa growth area located on the southeast end of Madera County and the north side of Fresno County.

Representatives from both counties then shared plans for the creation of groundwater agencies to tackle issues under Gov. Jerry Brown's groundwater management act approved last year
