

Nine Valley RadioShack locations slated for closure

At least nine Central Valley RadioShack locations are on the chopping block as the struggling electronics retailer seeks to unload stores as part of its bankruptcy plan.

[RadioShack put a 22-page list](#) on its website of potential store closures, which include nearly half of the 21 locations in Fresno, Kings, Madera and Tulare counties. The Fresno-Clovis area is expected to lose at least five stores:

- 4029 W. Clinton Ave., Fresno
- 8805 N. Cedar Ave. Ste. 101, Fresno
- 4424 W. Shaw Ave., Fresno
- 1060 Fresno St., Fresno
- 1755 Herndon Ave., Ste. 103, Clovis
- 2851 Highland Ave. Ste. 109, Selma
- 3318 N. Dinuba Blvd., Ste. F, Visalia
- 114 N. 12th Ave., Ste. 109, Hanford
- 1583 Hillman St., Tulare

Stores slated for closure are expected to liquidate remaining inventory, though no timeline has been announced.

RadioShack struck a deal with investment firm Standard General that would have Sprint set up its own "store within a store" retail presence in up to 1,750 U.S. stores. The stores would take up about one-third of the retail space in each location.

The company, which has not turned a profit since 2011, employs about 27,500 people worldwide, according to its last annual report filed with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.

The Texas-based retailer has a total of about 4,000 stores in the U.S.

It also has more than 1,000 dealer franchise stores in 25 countries, stores operated by its Mexican subsidiary, and operations in Asia operations, which are not included in the Chapter 11 filing. It wants to sell them.
