

## **CPUC proposes \$5.6 million fine against PG&E for 2012 demolition ...**

State officials want Pacific Gas and Electric Co. to pay \$5.6 million to settle issues related to the 2012 death of a demolition worker at the utility's former power plant along Coffee Road.

PG&E's primary regulator, the California Public Utilities Commission, announced the proposed settlement Wednesday. It said an administrative law judge will review the proposal and decide whether to accept, reject or modify it.
