

No water subsidies

A chief executive officer shouldn't resort to finding subsidies for the anticipated increase in water rates for only certain single-family residential customers without first exploring other avenues to pay for the proposed southeast surface water treatment facility and new raw water pipelines to reduce a portion of the proposed water rates for all water customers.

Where's the CEO who built both the northeast and t-3 surface water treatment facilities without increasing the water rates?

That portion of the proposed rates for the proposed pipelines preferred by the state (\$98.4m) should be deleted, as the state should be expected to contribute the funds for its desired preference. The Fresno Irrigation District and Central Valley Project system of canals, which currently can deliver all the raw water allocations from both Friant and Pine Flat dams, is not broken.
