

Women's conference offering \$60K 'mini-grants'

The Central California Women's Conference (CCWC) is looking for nonprofits serving women and children to apply for \$60,000 in mini-grants.

Grant applications must be submitted to the CCWC board of directors by April 13 and awards will be made only to organizations serving women and children. The winners will be recognized at CCWC's Community Celebration Grant Reception on June 16. Criteria for grant applications are posted to the CCWC website.

Since being founded in 1988, CCWC has donated more than \$655,000 to nonprofits helping women and children in the Central Valley. Funding has benefited recipients by providing an array of services ranging from mammograms to food, shelter, clothing and education.

More than 81,000 women have attended the CCWC's annual event at the Fresno Convention and Entertainment Center in downtown Fresno. This year's event will be held on Sept. 22.
