

Valley residents named to state Water Commission, Community Colleges Board

Governor Jerry Brown appointed two local men and one woman to the California Water Commission and the California Community Colleges Board of Governors Wednesday.

Jose Del Bosque, Jr., 65, of Los Banos, was reappointed to the California Water Commission, where he has served since 2010. Del Bosque has been a partner at J and G Contract Labor Inc. since 2005 and president of Empresas Del Bosque Inc. since 1985. He is director-at-large at the California Melon Research Board. The position on the California Water Commission requires Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$100 per diem.

Maria Herrera, 32, of Visalia, was appointed to the California Water Commission. Herrera has been a community development specialist at Self-Help Enterprises since 2014.

Gary Reed, 68, of Porterville, was appointed to another term on the California Community Colleges Board of Governors, where he has served since 2005. This position requires Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$100 per diem.
