Last fall, we refunded more than \$4 million in agricultural deposits back to customers. PG&E proactively reviewed accounts and reached out to eligible customers with deposit refunds.

We also partnered with the California Farm Bureau Federation on a request to the California Public Utilities Commission to delay the ordered termination of two agriculture energy rates.
