[San Joaquin Valley Homes](#) will open its sixth neighborhood in the south Valley on Saturday. [San Marino](#) is a 95-home development on 26 acres at Riggin Avenue and South Shirk Road in northwest Visalia.



The homes range in size from 2,219 to 3,250 square-feet with three to six bedrooms. The houses have tech centers, spacious laundry rooms and large covered patios. There is an option for a casita, or in-law quarters.

Prices start in the low \$300,000s. The grand opening starts at 10 a.m. Saturday.

In Fresno, [Granville Urban Development](#) will unveil its latest downtown housing project on Wednesday.

[Brio on Broadway](#) is made up of 14 two- and three-story buildings that flank a small house on Broadway Street, between San Joaquin and Calaveras streets.

The house is part of the project. It serves as the leasing office. The development has 52 units ranging in size from 602 square feet to 2,173 square feet. Some apartments have attached garages and private patios or balconies.

Rent ranges from \$825 to \$1,500. Brio festivities begin at 10 a.m.
