

Fresno falls seven spots on national list of areas with most stolen cars

Fresno has fallen seven spots on the National Insurance Crime Bureau's annual list of areas with the most stolen cars in the U.S.

Fresno was previously ranked second on the NICB's 2013 report but has now come in ninth. More than 5,200 cars were stolen in Fresno in 2014, a significant reduction from the more than 6,700 reported stolen in 2013. The San Francisco area topped the list, with more than 29,000 cars reported stolen in 2014.
