

## Fresno State's Ag One Foundation has new president

Debbie Raven, CEO and president of Valley Small Business Development Corporation, started her one-year term as president of Fresno State's Ag One Foundation on July 1.

The Ag One Foundation has raised more than \$17 million since 1979 to support the Jordan College of Agricultural Sciences and Technology, with more than \$2.5 million in scholarships and grants given to more than 3,500 students.
