The Tulare County Farm Bureau, working with Kings County Farm Bureau and State Compensation Insurance Fund, is hosting seminar training on safely harvesting nuts July 22 at the Kings Fairgrounds in Hanford.

The training is in English and Spanish and is directed at harvest equipment operators, crews and farm employees. Participants will receive a certificate after completing the safety training, which covers equipment for walnuts, almonds and pistachios.

Training begins at 8 a.m. and ends at 1:30 p.m. Lunch will be provided.
