

Clovis Unified to name newest school after administrator

Virginia 'Ginny' Boris was selected as the official namesake of Clovis Unified's newest elementary school during a governing board meeting on Sept. 23. Clovis Unified School District has unveiled plans to name its newest elementary school after longtime administrator Virginia 'Ginny' Boris.

Boris worked in the district as a math teacher, principal and curriculum leader from 1971 until her retirement in 2008. She remains active in mentoring teachers and others in the local education community through her work at Fresno State and the Central Valley Educational Leadership Institute.

"I am humbled, overwhelmed and honored because I love this district," Boris said. "I cannot think of a higher honor that you could bestow upon me than by putting my name on a place that is devoted to learning and teaching."

The decision to name the new elementary school after Boris was finalized during the Sept. 23 district governing board meeting.

Located at the corners of Temperance and Clinton avenues, the Virginia R. Boris Elementary School will open to students next August.
