

## WalletHub: Fresno 2nd worst city to find a job in '16

WalletHub has ranked Fresno the 2nd-worst U.S. city to find a job in 2016. A new national analysis of 2016's best and worst cities to find a job ranks Fresno near the bottom of the list.

WalletHub's [analysis](#) places Fresno as the second-worst place in the U.S. to land a job, or 149th out of 150 of the most populous cities. WalletHub evaluated the cities based on 17 metrics ranging from job opportunities to employment growth to monthly median starting salary.

Fresno's best rank actually came in employment growth, where it was placed above average at 69th. The lowest marks came in job opportunities (139th), unemployment rate (149th) and percentage of workforce living under the poverty line (144th).

Fresno was tied for last with Detroit in the unemployment rate category.

The best city to find a job for 2016 was Plano, Texas, while the highest-ranked California city was Irvine at No. 7. Sacramento came in at No. 96, while Bakersfield was ranked 130th.

Fresno was ranked ahead only of Stockton, which came in dead last.
