

Women's conference has \$70K for nonprofits

The Central California Women's Conference (CCWC) is seeking mini-grant applications from local non-profits serving women and children.

The CCWC board of directors is giving away a total of \$70,000 and grant winners will be recognized during the organization's Community Celebration Grant Reception on Wednesday, April 6.

Criteria for grant submission can be found at www.ccwc-fresno.org. All grant applications must be submitted by Jan. 25 and awards will be made only to Central Valley nonprofits focusing on women and children.

To date, CCWC has donated more than \$665,000 to Valley non-profits serving women and children. Funding has benefited recipients by providing an array of services including mammograms, food, shelter, clothing and education.

Now in its 29th year, more than 84,000 women have attended the CCWC's annual event. This year's conference will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 20 at the Fresno Convention & Entertainment Center.
